- 1) Explain the offence of Dowry Death K2 (2)
- 2) Define Culpable homicide. K1 (3)
- 3) Explain the essentials of "Sudden Quarrel" as exception to offence of murder. K2 (4)
- 4) Z attempts to horsewhip A, not in such a manner as to cause grievous hurt to A. A draws out a pistol. Z persists in the assault. A believing in good faith that he can by no other means prevent himself from being horsewhipped, shoots Z dead. Discuss the offence committed by A. Substantiate your answer with relevant legal provisions K2 (6)
- 5) A places men with firearms at the outlets of a building, and tells Z that they will fire at Z if Z attempts leave the building. Discuss the liability of A and also explain the relevant legal provisions. K3 (6)
- 6) In every Robbery there is either theft or Extortion. Discuss K3 (9)
- 7) Explain the offence of sexual harassment against women. K4 (8)
- 8) Krisha, a girl of 15 years and 10 months was married to Gaurang. Believing Gaurang's identical twin Swadesh to be Gaurang, Krisha had wilful sexual intercourse with Swadesh who knew of her mistaken belief. Krisha realised her mistake later. Examine the facts and advise Krisha if Swadesh can be successfully prosecuted for rape of Krisha? K4 (12)
