OBJECTIVES

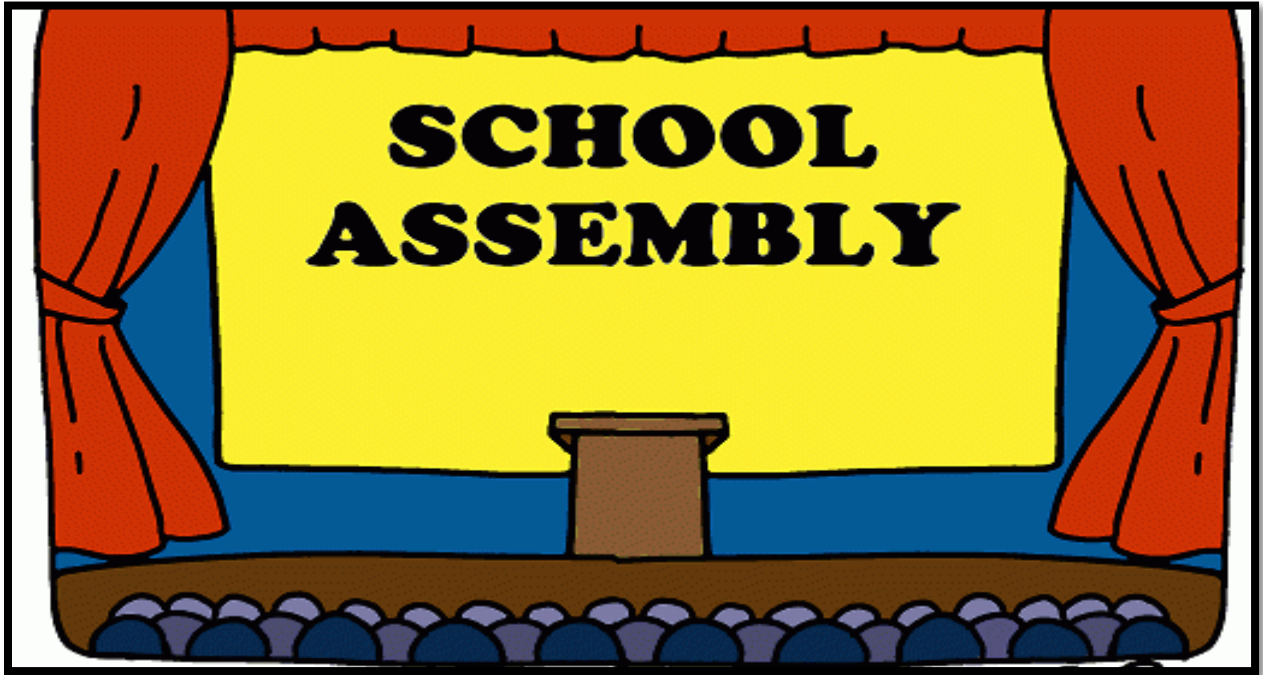
- ☉ To develop unity among all the students and teachers and creating the environment of school unity.

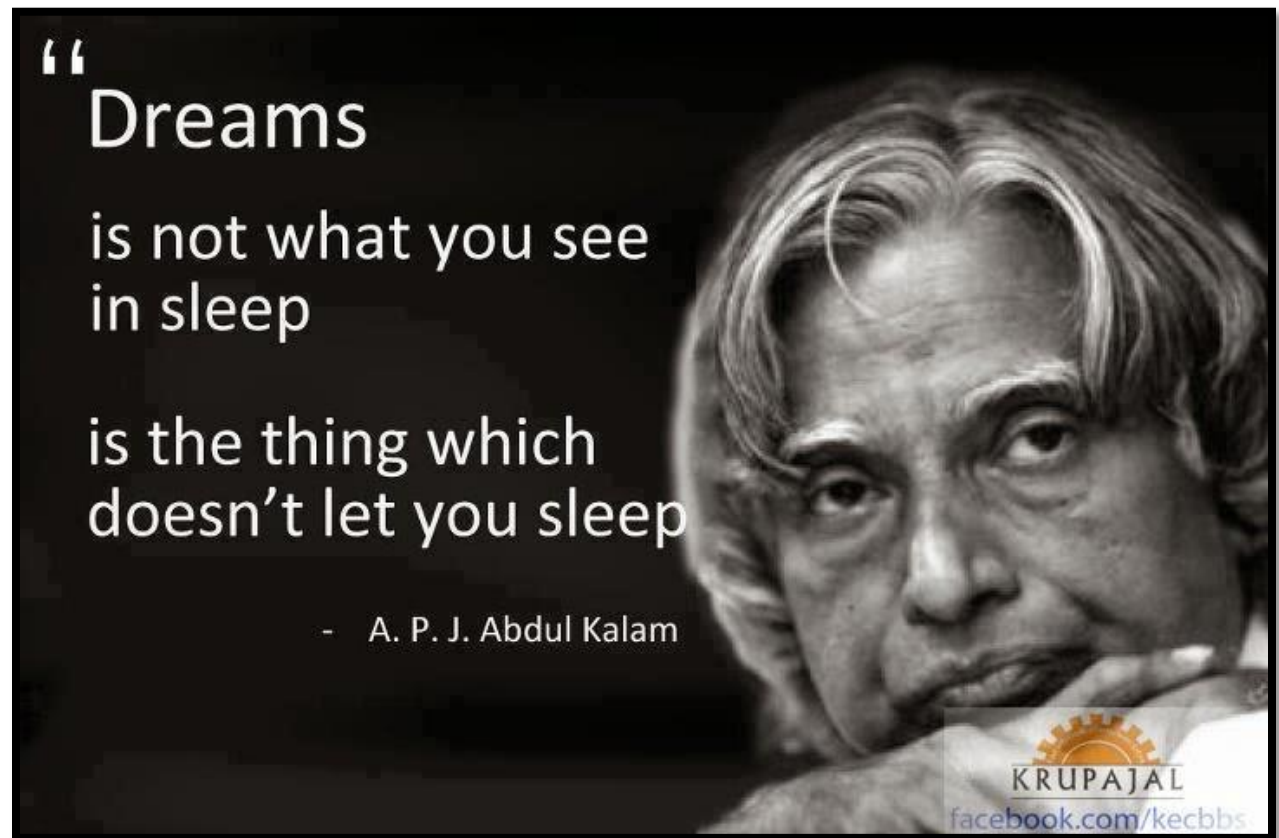


THOUGHT OF THE DAY

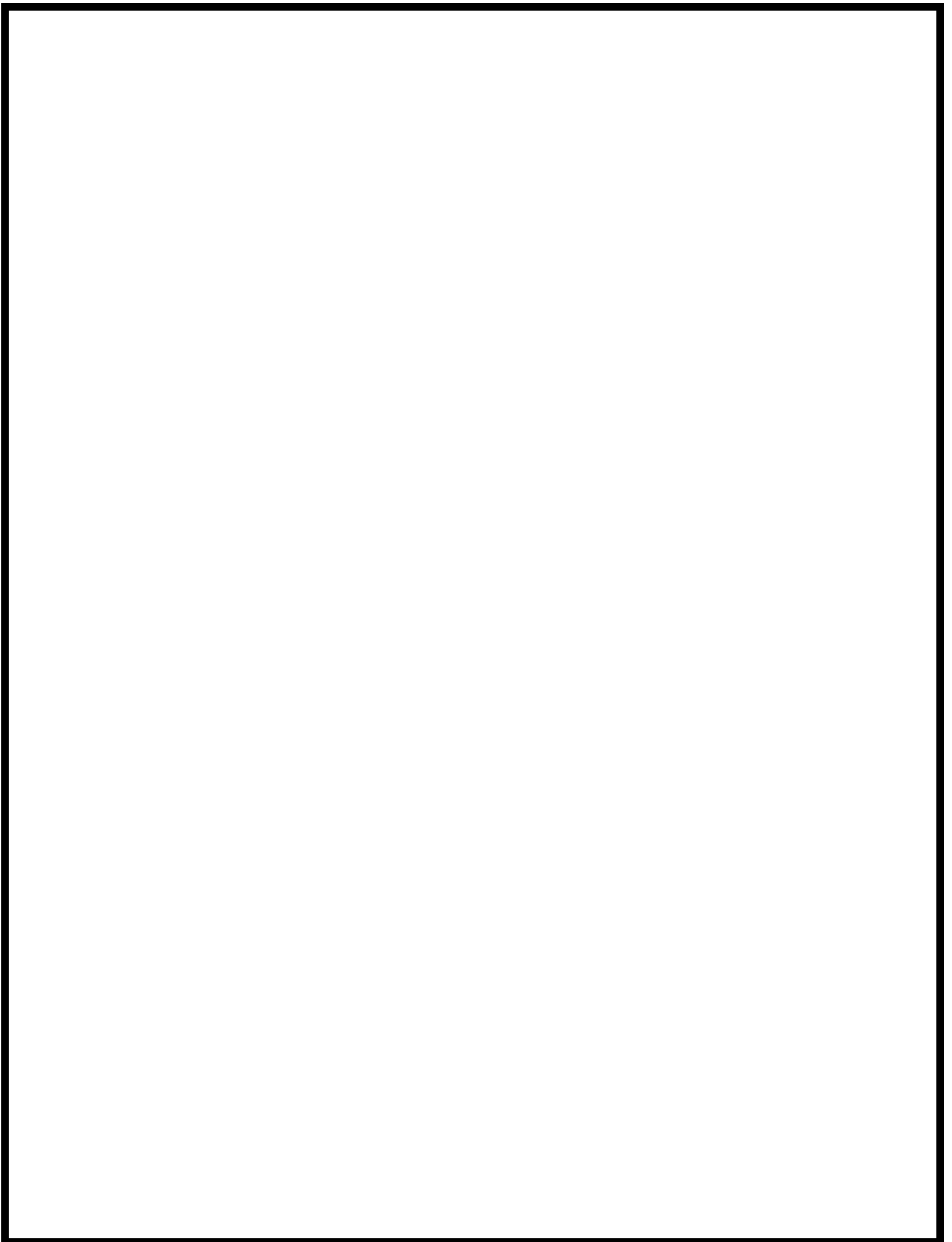
QUIZ

ABOUT THE THEME

It is the 74th Indian Independence Day this year which means India has achieved 73 years of freedom. THEME-HINDI DIWAS

DATE-24/09/2020

भारत में हर साल 14 सितंबर को हिन्दी दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाता है. साल 1947 में देश के आजाद होने के बाद संविधान में नियमों और कानून के अलावा नए राष्ट्र की आधिकारिक भाषा का मुद्दा भी अहम था, जिसके बाद 14 सितंबर 1949 को संविधान सभा ने एक मत से निर्णय लिया कि हिन्दी ही भारत की राजभाषा होगी. हिंदी को देश की राजभाषा घोषित किए जाने के दिन ही हर साल हिंदी दिवस (Hindi Diwas 2020) मनाने का फैसला किया गया. पहला हिंदी दिवस 14 सितंबर 1953 को मनाया गया. तब से अभी तक हर साल 14 सितंबर को हिंदी दिवस मनाया जाता है. आपको बता दें कि हिन्दी दिवस के अलावा हर साल 10 जनवरी को विश्व हिन्दी दिवस भी मनाया जाता है.

क्या है हिन्दी दिवस का इतिहास?

यूं तो भारत विभिन्नताओं वाला देश है. यहां हर राज्य की अपनी अलग सांस्कृतिक, राजनीतिक और ऐतिहासिक पहचान है. यही नहीं सभी जगह की बोली भी अलग है. इसके बावजूद हिन्दी भारत में सर्वाधिक बोली जाने वाली भाषा है. यही वजह है कि राष्ट्रपिता महात्मा गांधी ने हिन्दी को जनमानस की भाषा कहा था. उन्होंने 1918 में आयोजित हिन्दी साहित्य सम्मेलन में हिन्दी को राष्ट्र भाषा बनाने के लिए कहा था.

आजादी मिलने के बाद लंबे विचार-विमर्श के बाद आखिरकार 14 सितंबर 1949 को संविधान सभा में हिन्दी को राज भाषा बनाने का फैसला लिया गया. भारतीय संविधान के भाग 17 के अध्याय की धारा 343 (1) में हिन्दी को राजभाषा बनाए जाने के संदर्भ में कुछ इस तरह लिखा गया है, 'संघ की राजभाषा हिन्दी और लिपि देवनागरी होगी. संघ के राजकीय प्रयोजनों के लिए प्रयोग होने वाले अंकों का रूप अंतर्राष्ट्रीय रूप होगा.'

हालांकि हिन्दी को राजभाषा बनाए जाने से काफी लोग खुश नहीं थे और इसका विरोध करने लगे. इसी विरोध के चलते बाद में अंग्रेजी को भी राजभाषा का दर्जा दे दिया गया.

हिन्दी दिवस क्यों मनाया जाता है?

भारत सालों तक अंग्रेजों का गुलाम रहा. इसी वजह से उस गुलामी का असर लंबे समय तक देखने को मिला. यहां तक कि इसका प्रभाव भाषा में भी पड़ा. वैसे तो हिन्दी दुनिया की चौथी ऐसी भाषा है जिसे सबसे ज्यादा

लोग बोलते हैं, लेकिन इसके बावजूद हिन्दी को अपने ही देश में हीन भावना से देखा जाता है. आमतौर पर हिन्दी बोलने वाले को पिछड़ा और अंग्रेजी में अपनी बात कहने वाले को आधुनिक कहा जाता है.

इसे हिन्दी का दुर्भाग्य ही कहा जाएगा कि इतना समृद्ध भाषा कोष होने के बावजूद आज हिन्दी लिखते और बोलते वक्त ज्यादातर अंग्रेजी भाषा के शब्दों का इस्तेमाल किया जाता है और हिन्दी के कई शब्द चलन से ही हट गए. ऐसे में हिन्दी दिवस को मनाना जरूरी है, ताकि लोगों को यह याद रहे कि हिन्दी उनकी राजभाषा है और उसका सम्मन व प्रचार-प्रसार करना उनका कर्तव्य है. हिन्दी दिवस मनाने के पीछे मंशा यही है कि लोगों को एहसास दिलाया जा सके कि जब तक वे इसका इस्तेमाल नहीं करेंगे तब तक इस भाषा का विकास नहीं होगा.

HISTORY OF WORLD POPULATION DAY:

The day came about in 1989 when it was established by the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme. It was inspired by the public interest in Five Billion Day on July 11, 1987, the approximate date on which the world's population reached five billion people. The United Nations General Assembly decided to continue observing the day through its resolution 45/216 of December 1990.

SIGNIFICANCE OF WORLD POPULATION DAY:

The day is significant because it highlights the problems of overpopulation, raises awareness about the effects of overpopulation on the environment and development. It also talks about the health problems faced by child bearing women and the importance of family planning, gender equality, poverty, maternal health and human rights.

THEME OF WORLD POPULATION DAY 2020:

The theme this year is based on safeguarding the health and rights of women and girls around the world especially during the time of COVID-19 pandemic. A recent UNFPA research highlighted that if the lockdown continues for 6 months, and there is major disruption to health services, then 47 million women in low and middle-income countries might not have access to modern contraceptives. This would in turn lead to 7 million unintended pregnancies. Apart from that, it could see a rise in gender-based violence, female genital mutilation and child marriages.

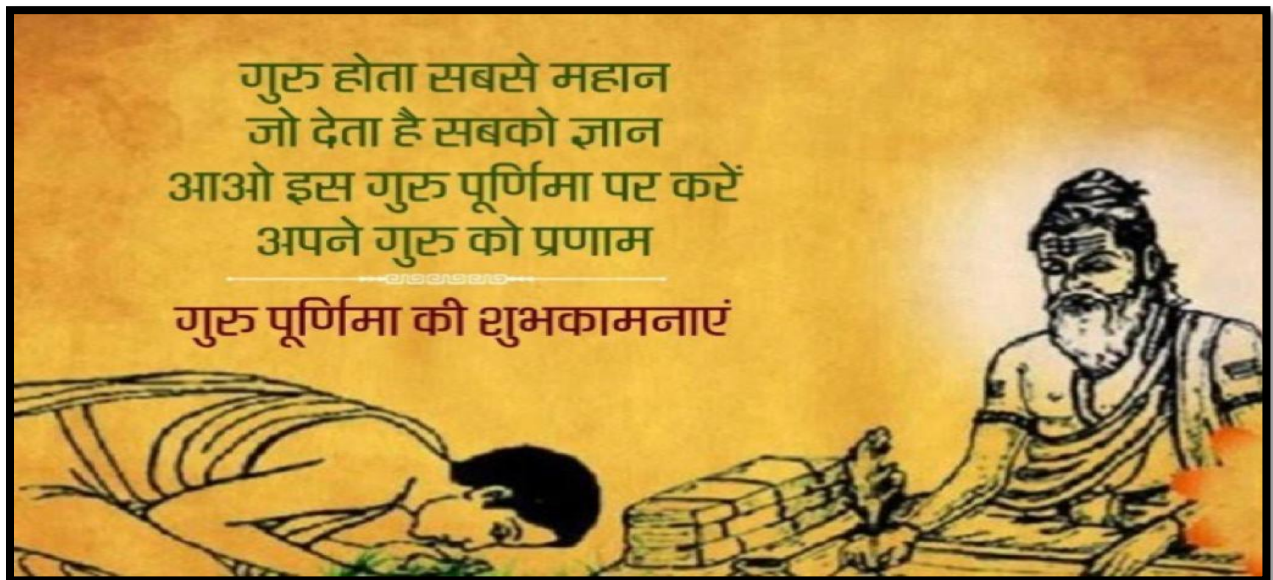


ASSEMBLY THEME-GURUPURNIMA

ABOUT THE THEME

The day of full moon, Purnima, in the month of Ashadh is traditionally celebrated as Guru Purnima by Hindus. Also known as Vyas Purnima, the day is celebrated in remembrance and veneration to sage Ved Vyas. THE NEED OF A GURU

The Sanskrit root "Gu" means darkness or ignorance. "Ru" denotes the remover of that darkness. Therefore one who removes darkness of our ignorance is a Guru. Only he who removes our ultimate darkness, known as Maya, and who inspires and guides us on to the path of God-realization is the true Guru. Students also refer to their school teacher or college lecturer as guru. The connotation of the word guru in this case is one who imparts temporal knowledge (Apara Vidya) and is thus accordingly offered respect.

According to the latest Global Trends for Youth 2020: technology and the future of jobs, since 2017, there has been an upward trend in the number of youth not in employment, education or training (NEET).

Around 259 million young people in 2016 classified as NEET and this number rose to an estimated 267 million in 2019 and it is said it will rise to around 273 million in 2021. In terms of percentage, the trend is slightly up from 21.7% in 2015 to 22.4% in 2020 and implying that the international target to reduce the NEET rate by 2020 will be missed.

In 2014, the General Assembly declared to celebrate the World Youth Skills Day on 15 July with an aim to provide a chance for young youth, technical and vocational education and training (TVET) institutions, public and private sector stakeholders to recognise and celebrate the importance of preparing young youth with skills of employment, decent work, and entrepreneurship.

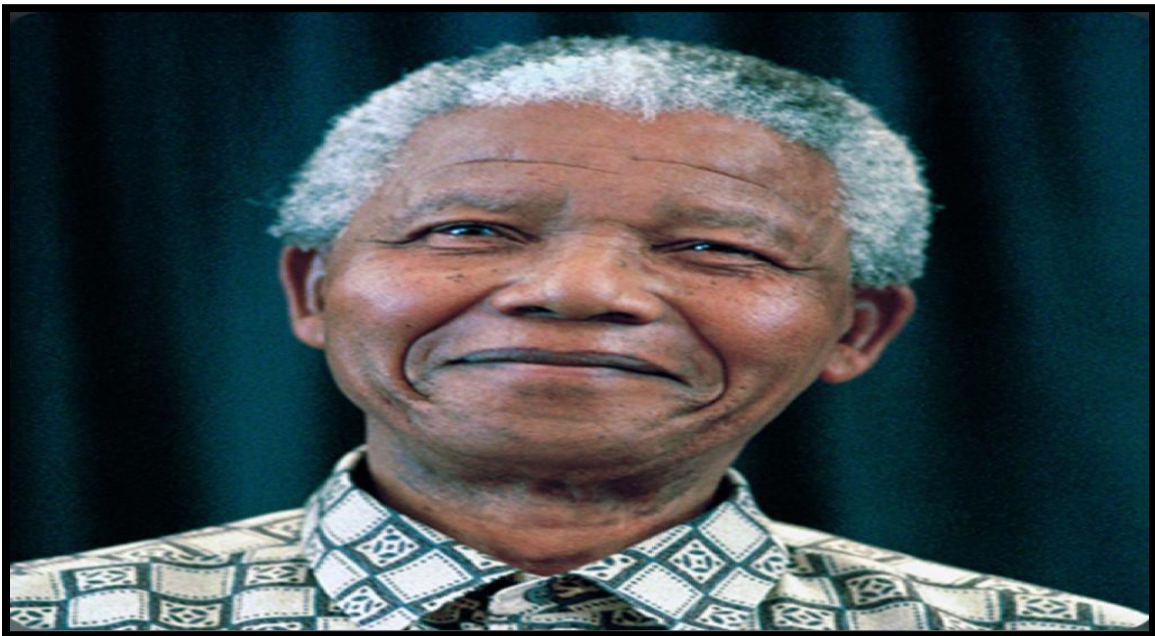

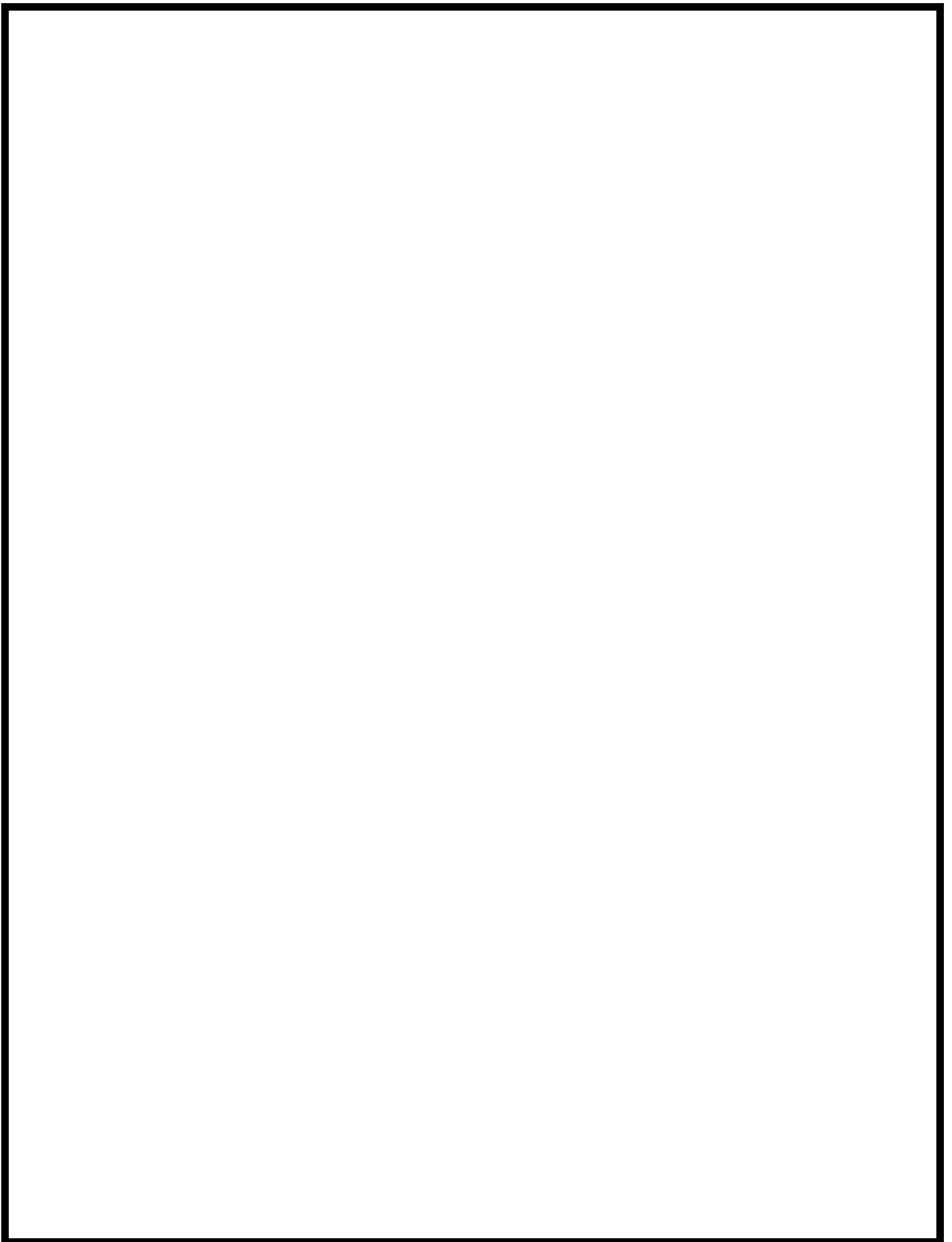

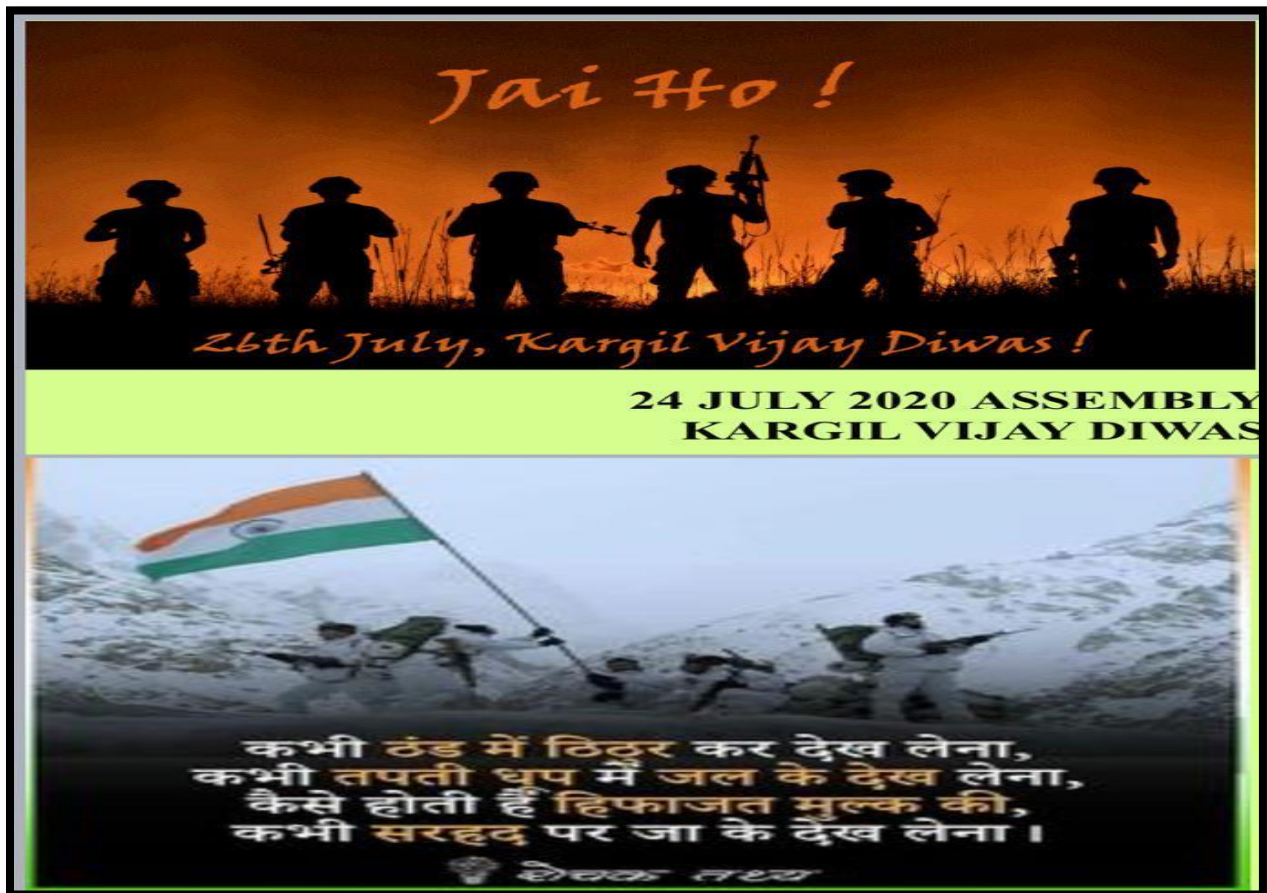
ABOUT THE THEME



ABOUT THE THEME

Included in the Constitution on October 17, 1949, Article 370 exempts J&K from the Indian Constitution (except Article 1 and Article 370 itself) and permits the state to draft its own Constitution. It restricts Parliament's legislative powers in respect of J&K. For extending a central law on subjects included in the Instrument of Accession (IoA), mere "consultation" with the state government is needed. But for extending it to other matters, "concurrence" of the state government is mandatory. The IoA came into play when the Indian Independence Act, 1947 divided British India into India and Pakistan.

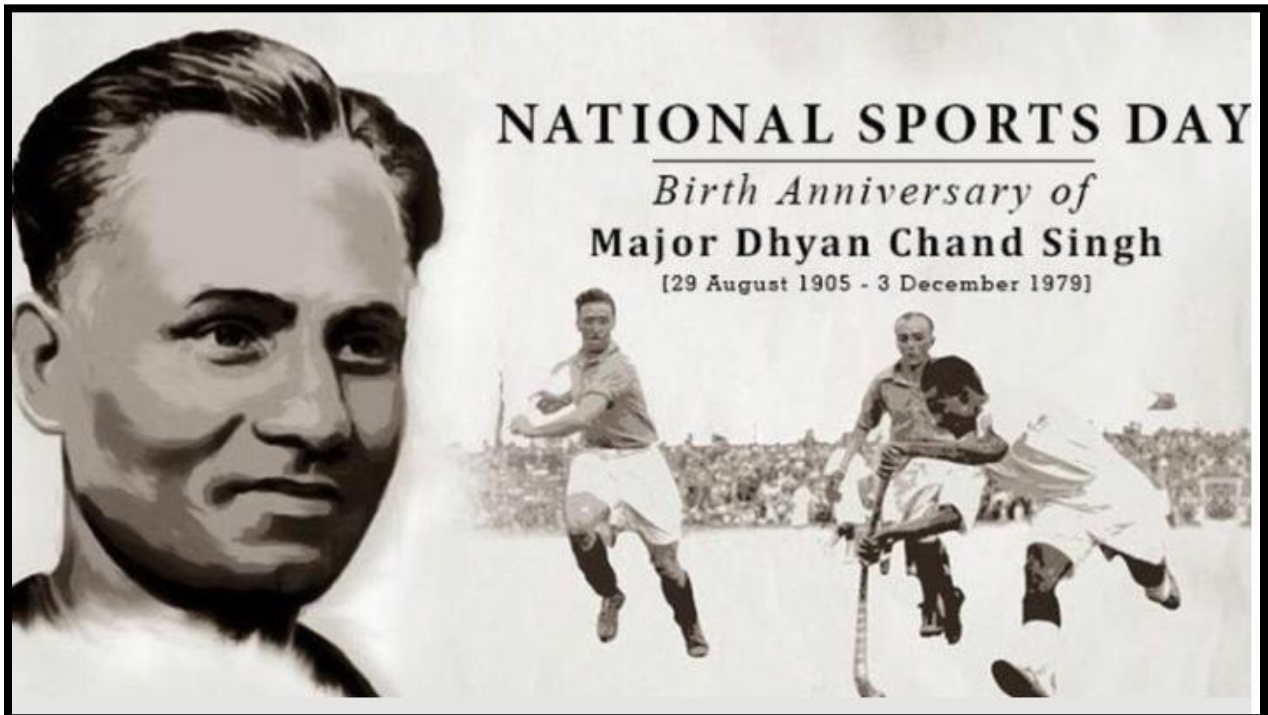
