Principles of Supervision

1. Supervision is an *ongoing* process.

4. Supervision *respects the individuality* of the staff members.
5. Supervision *differ* from staff to student.
6. Supervision strives to make the unit a *good learning* situation.
7. Supervisors must possess sound *professional knowledge*.
