


 The uterus when displaced backward is term as retroverted uterus and when it is displaced downward is know as uterine prolapse

Causes

- Repeated pregnancy at closer intervals
- Lifting heavy objects during an early postnatal period
- women pursuing career in sports and dances or who do heavy exercises
- During child birth when the woman has laceration
- Habitual constipation
- Constant or habitual distension of bladder
- Tumors (pelvic or abdomen)
- Injury to sacrum
- After difficult labor


