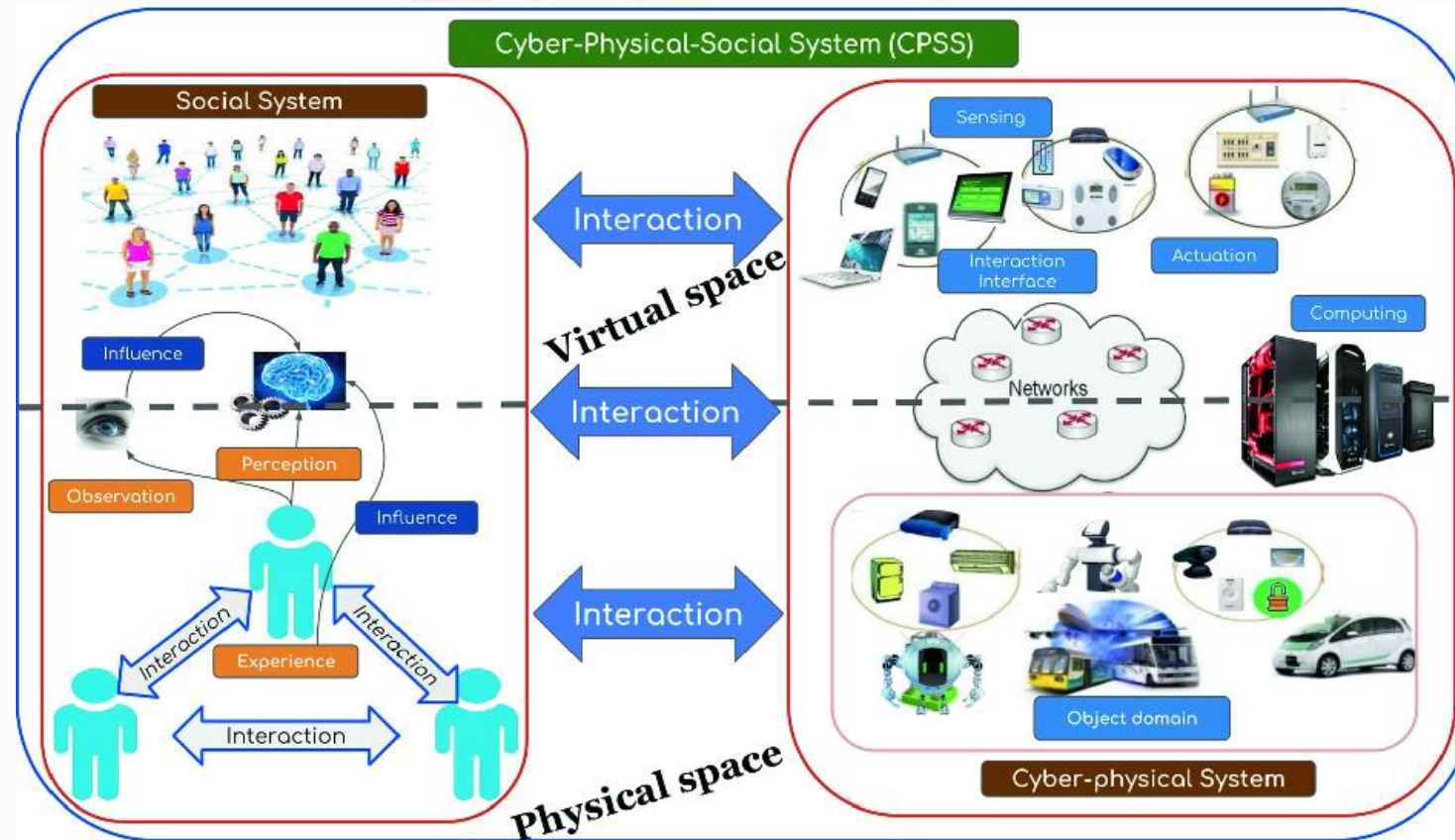






Organizations are cyber-physical-social systems.

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Organizations Behaviour is study and application of knowledge how people act within the organization. Corporate Governance and Business Ethics

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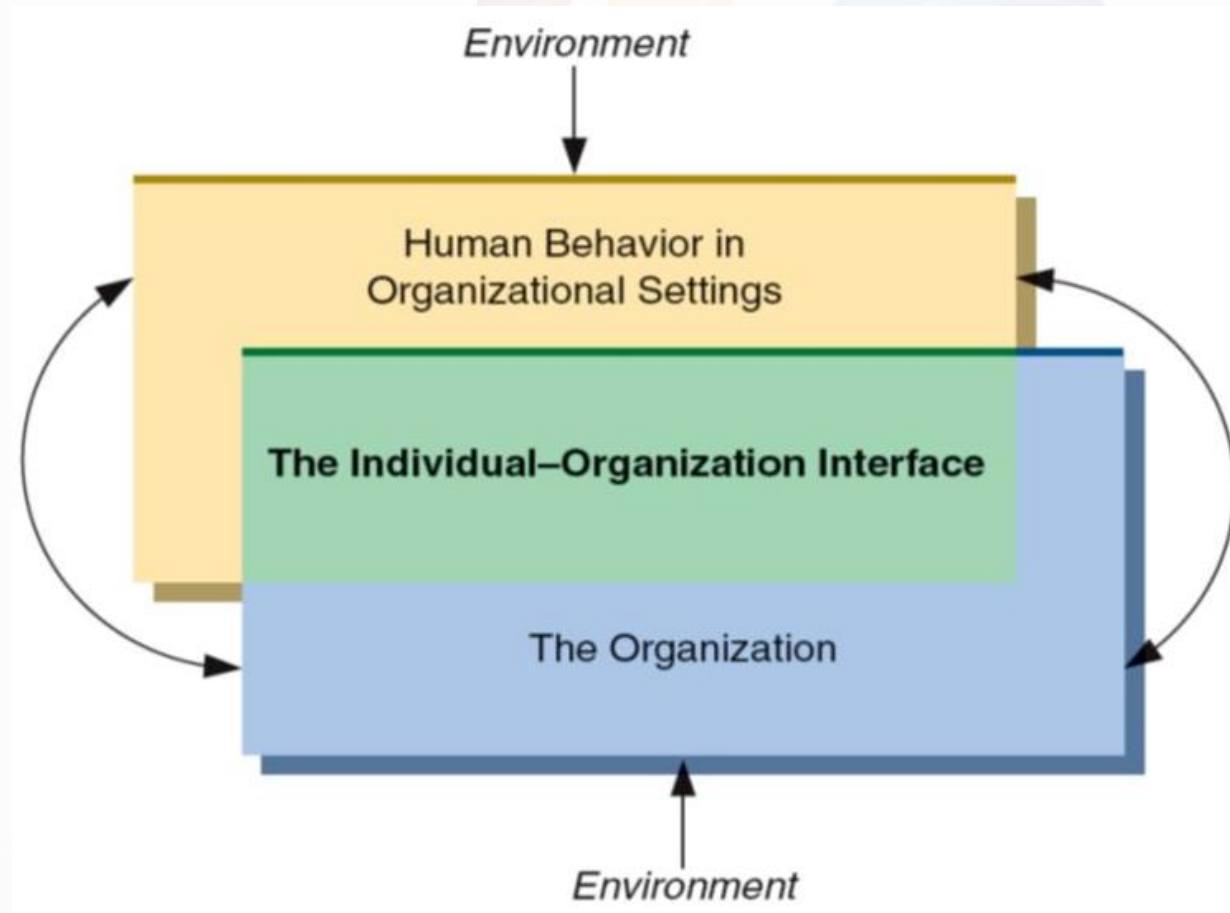
The complex forces that act on organizations:

## Evolution of Organizational Behaviour

### **Robert Owen-(1800)**

- Young Factory Owner-First to emphasize the human needs of employees and refused to employ children
- Taught workers to improve working conditions
- Father of personnel management

### **Andrew Ure-(1835)**

- The Philosophy of Manufacturers -1835
- Value of human factor in manufacturing
- Provided welfare facilities to workers

**J.N. TATA** in 1886 Instituted a pension fund & 1895 began to pay accident compensation.
